RULES AND REGULATIONS

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: Office will close one hour before each performance. Entries for classes within a performance should be made prior to that closing. Check posted hours for additional closings.

PARKING: The use of the parking parcel to the North of the property is allowed. All vehicles and trailers shall park in a uniformed manner in this parking parcel only. No camping will be permitted on the parking parcels. No vehicle access shall be permitted to the parking parcels from Equine Drive. No emptying or loading or trailers will be permitted on Arena Drive.

\$25 CHARGE FOR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES: Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/trainer/handler will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership or lease, copies of current ASHBA and AHHA membership cards must accompany entry blanks, which must include the REQUIRED three signatures and complete addresses for owners and trainers.

OPEN CHECK: To facilitate office procedures, all exhibitors/trainers are <u>required to leave a blank</u> <u>signed check in the show office before numbers will be released.</u>

REFUNDS: Exhibitors cancelling entries after closing date without a vet certificate shall forfeit their entry fees. **No Refund Of Stall Rent, Office Or Association Fees.** No refunds during show.

FAILURE TO ENTER/SCRATCH: A \$25 fine is charged to any exhibitor who fails to enter or scratch an entry at least one hour prior to the start of performance in which entry would compete.

ARRIVAL: Stalls are available after 10 AM, Thursday, March 21st.

STABLING: 8' x 10' stalls on dirt.. Electric and water available. No showing out of trailers. Every horse must have a stall.

ASHBA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Beginning with the 2019 competition year, owners, riders, drivers, handlers and trainers of American Saddlebred horses showing at open shows recorded with ASHBA must be current ASHBA competing members for points counted for KSF/WCHS Qualifying, National Pleasure and ASHBA High Point Awards. Effective February 4, 2019, any individual that appears on the Safe Sport or USEF banned or suspended lists cannot be in attendance, compete or participate in such competition in any manner, including as a trainer, coach, owner or exhibitor of horses or ponies.

ALL HORSES: Horses coming into Illinois must have a Health Certificate and negative Coggins for Equine Infectious Anemia within the prior 12 months, and proof of Rhinopneumonitis (Rhino/flu) vaccination within 6 months of entering stables.

STAKE/CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY: For regular Stake and Championship classes horse/pony must be entered, shown and judged in class in same section. To qualify for Amateur, Adult or Junior Exhibitor Stake/Championship, horse/pony must have been shown in a class in the same section by an amateur or junior exhibitor.

PRIZES OFFERED: Trophy and Ribbons, 1st through 8th place will be awarded in all classes.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED

RING SIZES, FOOTING: Show ring is 150' x 100', warm-up is 50' x 100'. Footing for both rings is sand/sawdust. Totally enclosed, fully heated facility.

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT: Any and all entries in this horse show shall be conditioned upon the following terms and conditions: The Mid-America Spring Fling Horse Show, Mid-America Horse Show Association, Ledges Sporting Horses Stable, show management and sponsors will be in no case responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold them blameless for any loss or injury which may occur by fire, theft or otherwise.

MID-AMERICA MEMBERS ONLY: Exhibitors (defined as owners, riders and trainers in performance classes; riders and instructors only in equitation and academy classes) must be current members of Mid-America Horse Show Association. SUNRISE JUNIOR HORSE HUNTER CHALLENGE

The Sunrise Junior Horse Hunter Challenge is open to **American Saddlebred** horses 4 years and under and shown by an Amateur or Professional. The **entry fee is \$50** which will be added back in to the class payout of \$350. Payouts will be 40%, 20%, 15%, 10%, 5% for each class. If less than 6 horses are in the class, money not paid out will be divided evenly amongst ribbon winners.

Class Specs and Procedure: Open to four-year-olds and under. May be shown by a professional or amateur. To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot, canter and extended canter both ways of the ring. Entries must be asked both ways of the ring to halt and stand quietly on the rail. To be judged on suitability as a Hunter, manners, performance, conformation, and quality. In the line, horses must stand quietly with all four legs perpendicular to the ground. Horse shall be required to back readily in the line.
